May 16: Walk from Neda to Pontedeume - 12.7km/7.9 miles

May 17: Walk from Pontedeume to Miño - 9.6km/6.0 miles

May 18: Walk from Miño to Betanzos - 10.9km/6.8 miles

May 19: Walk from Betanzos to Presedo - 12.4km/7.7 miles

May 20: Walk from Presedo to Meson do Ventó - 15.4km/9.6 miles

May 21: Walk from Meson do Ventó to Sigüeiro - 27.0km/16.8 miles

May 22: Walk from Sigüeiro To Santiago de Compostela - 17.2km/10.7 miles

May 23: Explore Santiago de Compostela

May 24: Depart Santiago de Compostela
