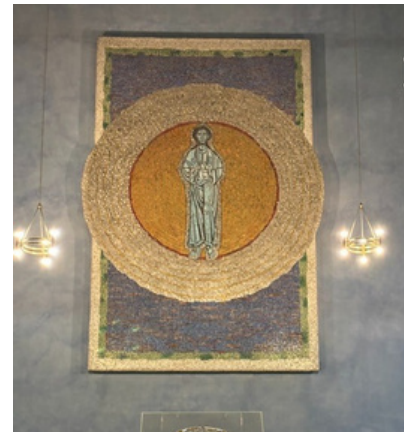
These are just a few of the descriptors used for Hildegard of Bingen, a medieval saint whose impact on theology, music, botany, and medicine is still felt today.

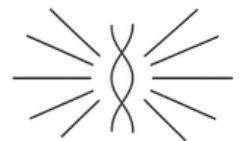

June 10: Walk from Monzingen to Disibodenberg; (13.6 km/8.5 mi)

June 11: Walk from Disibodenberg to Schlossbockelheim (15.5 km/9.6 mi)

June 12: Walk from Schlossbockelheim to Braunweiler (15.9 km/9.9 mi)

June 13: Walk from Braunweiler to Stromberg (19.3 km/12 mi)

June 14: Walk from Stromberg to Bingen am Rhein (19.5 km/12.1 mi)

June 15: Explore Bingen/Explore Rudesheim

June 16: Explore Bingen/Explore Rudesheim

June 17: Depart Rudesheim
